INTRODUCTION:

Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, an Autonomous Organization under Ministry of Human Resource Development, Govt. of India was established in the year 1986 on the basis of one Vidyalaya on one District.

Vidyalayas are functioning in 27 States & 07 Union Territories across the country excluding State of Tamil Nadu.

With reference to the fast changing School Education Scenario in the country, the Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya have established a reputation for their academic performance and other activities related to the holistic development of the personality of the children. Within three decades, since its inception, the Navodaya Vidyalaya have brought a revolution in the Secondary & Sr.Secondary education system through a remix of Indian culture and Modern education.

The Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya (JNVs) function under the Ministry of HRD, Deptt. of School Education & Literacy, Govt. of India and are affiliated to the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). Admission to Vidyalaya is done at the Class –VI level through an open test conducted at District level by the NVS. About 80 students are admitted in each JNV which ensure all-round development of the personality of children by providing good academic guidance apart from input in other non-scholastic areas by providing good facilities for Sport, NCC, Scouts & Guides adventure activities, Computer education etc.

One of the salient features of the Navodaya Vidyalaya is Migration under which 30% of children studying in Class-IX from Navodaya in a Hindi speaking states gets shifted for studies in a JNV of Non-Hindi speaking states and vice-versa and thus helps to promote National integration.

BREEF HISTORY OF OUR VIDYALAYA

Since 1986 several Navodaya Vidyalaya Started functioning in spite of Lack of proper infrastructure Initially Principal and staff members come on deputation basis and actual recruitment of permanent posts were done exclusively for this residential set up in the fall of eighties. Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, Narla was started in 1987 near Block Education in a rented building at Narla, The Vidyalaya shifted to its permanent site at Narla Campus in 1994. The first batch of 10th Standard appeared 1992. Then 28 batches have appeared board examination. The first batch of 12th Standard appeared in 1994 and so far 26 batches have written the AISSCE till now. The total strength of the Vidyalaya is 573.

At present the Vidyalaya is having a beautiful permanent Campus on 30 acrs land. Inside the Campus all facilities like water, Electricity, Play Ground, Guest House, Principal's residence and sufficient staff quarters. The main administrative building is a two storied building. There are 14 class rooms, different Labs for Practical like Physics, Chemistry, Biology Campur lab, Smart Room, A.V. Teaching aids room. Inside the administrative building principal's, Vice-Principal's chamber, staff room, Library, Exam-Dept, Medical room and Office are there. A big M.P. Hall (Multipurpose Hall) which is near to administrative building. All the public meetings, assembly of the students, cultural Programme and in door games are Conducted in it regularly. Goddess Saraswati, Ganesh and Durga Statues and Siva temple arranged in the Campus, which make the Campus very attractive and lively.

Four separate dormitories for boys and girls, 32 staff quarters, One Guest Room, Principal quarter, two Dining Halls are there inside the Campus. The avoid water problem inside the campus sub miscible pump is operating 24 hours. The school has high capacity overhead tank. A diesel generator is also there to avoid any kind of power interruption during the study of the children of the Vidyalaya. Generator is also provided to the houses.

House Systems

The Basis idea around which the whole Vidyalaya set up run is the house system. For the propose of C.C.A the students are divided into four houses.
